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# **Publications**

The International Organising Committee (IOC) have been exploring various publication opportunities for Proceedings of the Workshop.

At this stage the IOC do not have a commitment from a high profile Journal to publish a Special Issue of refereed papers as the Workshop Proceedings.

However the following arrangements have been put in place:

Research Letters in Information and Mathematical Sciences (RLIMS)

The Editors of DI MC will multiple a special issue of papers delivered at the Westeban A printed

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version of the special RLIMS issue will be made available to all participants and be available electronically on the web.

Note that RLIMS is a preprint series. After editing, articles are published online and can be referenced. Copyright remains with the authors. All participants will be able to submit their manuscript to a refereed journal for publication.

### International Statistical Review (ISR)

The IOC have agreed to an arrangement whereby participants delivering "synthesis and review" type statistical papers will, subject to the usual refereeing process, be given strong consideration for having their manuscript published in the International Statistical Review (ISR). This is a review journal, and does not cater for narrowly specialized papers. Publication will be fast once the referees' reports are positive. Participants are recommended to consult the Statement of Editorial Policy from the Editors of ISR.

### **Technical papers**

Participants presenting narrowly specialized technical papers should consider making a submission to Linear Algebra and its Applications , the Electronic Journal of Linear Algebra or an other relevant journal.

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
